

# Florence High School 2016-17 Educational Awards

## ***William Susman and Frances Susman Scholarship Awards***

- 1 scholarship of **\$8,000 (\$4,000 per semester)** (renewable for four years)
- Available for academic or vocational and tech based careers

## ***John T. Morris Scholarship Awards***

- 1 scholarship of **\$7,000 (3,500 per semester)** (renewable for four years)
  - 1 scholarship of **\$5,000 (2,500 per semester)** (renewable for four years)
  - Additional one year (OT) scholarships awarded based on application, interview and funds available
  - Possible continuation for prior recipients based on funds available and maintenance of 3.0 GPA
- \* Note: **Prior One Time Recipients** need to submit information including a **new** application, **new** letters Of recommendation, **current** transcripts etc.

## ***Maude Klepzig Memorial Scholarship Award***

- 1 scholarship of \$250.00 (non-renewable)

## ***Rotary Scholarship Award***

- 2 scholarships of \$250.00 (non-renewable)

## **FHS AWARD DESCRIPTIONS**

### **William Susman and Frances Susman Memorial Scholarship Award**

This is a renewable award available to Florence High School graduate for up to \$8,000 per year. The award is to provide tuition and fees for an Associates or Bachelors degree from an accredited institution of higher learning including **vocational and technology schools** in Colorado.

**Qualifications:** GPA and current academic performance will be considered though a minimum GPA is not required. The Committee will give equal consideration to **vocational, technical**, and 2- or 4-year Colorado institutions. The applicant must graduate from Florence High School and have attended FHS for at least two years. This automatic renewable scholarship will be awarded for up to 4 four years with a cumulative 3.0 GPA

### **John T. Morris Memorial Scholarship Awards**

These awards will vary in amounts for Florence High School graduates attending post-secondary institutions. The Florence High School Educational Awards Committee will give equal consideration to students applying to technical, vocational, 2- or 4-year institutions. Two automatic renewable scholarships in the amount of \$7,000 and \$5,000 per year will be awarded. Additional one year scholarships will vary in amount depending on funds available to the foundation. The (OT) awards may be renewed with possible continuation for more than one year contingent on students maintaining a cumulative 3.0 GPA and completing a new application.

**Qualifications:** The applicant must be a graduating Florence High School student and attending an accredited college, vocational school, or other post-secondary institution. The two automatic renewable scholarships will be awarded for up to 4 four years if student maintains a cumulative 3.0 GPA

***Applications must be received at Florence High School by 12:00 noon on Thursday, April 17, 2016.***

***Applications received prior to Thursday March 24, 2016 will be reviewed to ensure all components are complete. If not complete, applicants will be notified.***
