Ector loved life. He loved country music, fishing and the sport of bowling. His family was the world to him, the grandkids were always at the bowling alley helping him or just learning from him. Ector participated in numerous bowling competitions to include local levels, state levels and national levels. His family and friends would even travel with him for these competitions. Between 2003 and 2013 Ector had seven 300 games plus numerous other awards. Bowlers of all ages would look to Ector for guidance on their bowling. He was always there to help or even just to listen. Ector Rodriguez was truly an amazing man with a lot to give and never asked for anything in return.

Scholarship Requirements

1. Only one Male and one Female Senior Student will be chosen for a \$1000 Scholarship apiece.
2. Students must reside and attend a High School in Fremont County.
3. No restriction as to College, University, or Trade/Vocational School which individual plans to attend, in or out of the State of Colorado as long as it is within 2 years of graduation.
4. No restriction as to subject matter studied.
5. Recipient must have a 3.0 or higher grade point average.
6. Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the College, University or Trade/Vocational School the recipient will attend.
 - A. Awarded funds may only be used for tuition, books and required materials.
 - B. Recipients must supply College, University, or Trade/Vocational School address for mailing of awarded funds.
7. All applications will be held confidential and will not be returned to the applicants.
8. 20 Hours of community service. Please attach a log of Hours and have it signed by supervisors.

(Scholarship criteria may be modified upon the recommendation of the Scholarship Committee and the approval of the Board of Directors)
