Pueblo Community College-Fremont Campus

- Qualifying freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors can take PCC college classes at Florence High School campus in their regular school schedule.
- Qualifying sophomores, juniors and seniors can take up to **two** classes per semester at Pueblo Community College. Florence High School will pay up to **six** credit hours any additional credit hours will be at the expense of the student.
- Each semester PCC will have classes available on Fridays for our students. Transportation for Friday classes can be arranged through the counseling office.

Students who sign up for this option must apply to PCC online. Students who do not have qualifying ACT PSAT or SAT scores will need to take the Accuplacer or other equivalent exam chosen by PCC

*Students who take classes **ON** PCC's Campus must enroll in Guaranteed Transfer Courses Only (otherwise the cost will be to the student/parent or guardian)*

The course cannot be taken if it is offered at FHS (example: Composition, Foreign Language)

Post secondary option form (letter of interest) must be filled out and returned before you may take any college credit course

Post Secondary Letter of Interest 2019-2020

Students who intend to take classes through Pueblo Community college must complete this **Letter of Interest** prior to starting classes.

1. **Concurrent Enrollment** courses are available to qualified students.
 - a. Students must enroll in a Guaranteed Transfer (GT) course or Career Technical Education (CTE) course.
 - b. Students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5.
 - c. Students must meet the college pre-requisite requirements for each class.
 - d. The ACT, PSAT, SAT or Accuplacer must be completed with a passing score prior to enrollment in any college class.
 - e. All courses must relate to the students Individual Career & Academic Plan (ICAP).
2. College courses cannot substitute for classes taught at Florence High School.
3. Online courses cannot be taken if an equivalent course is offered on campus.
4. College courses will appear on both the high school and college transcript (student must request official transcript from college when applying to other schools).
5. **A letter grade of "C" or above must be earned or the student/parent/guardian is responsible to reimburse tuition cost to the Fremont RE-2 school district.**
6. **If a student receives lower than a "C", they will be required to take one semester off of concurrent enrollment courses.**
7. College courses must be a minimum of three (3) college semester hours to qualify for .5 high school unit of credit.
8. Grades earned in college classes will be factored in for student's cumulative high school GPA.
9. Classes are available to students on a space available basis. Registration may be denied.
10. The student/parent/guardian is responsible for the cost of all books and or fees associated with the Concurrent Enrollment class(es).
11. If the student drops a course after the college's official drop deadline or if the student receives lower than a "C", the student/parent/guardian will be held fully responsible for all tuition and any other fee associated (*All outstanding debts will be added to the student's high school account and must be settled before a diploma will be distributed*).
12. In order to register for college courses, students must first be enrolled in the Colorado Opportunity Fund (COF).
