September:

Prepare a resume (if you don't already have one or need help there are many free templates online, ask one of your teachers or us down in the counseling office for help)

Register for the College Opportunity Fund (COF) if you are planning on going to college, this provides you with a discounted rate per college credit hour <https://cof.college-assist.org/>

Research and think through which college(s) you want to apply to. Each college typically charges an application fee (community colleges and tech schools are usually free)

Check emails from the school regularly, we will start sending any and all scholarships to you, they will also be posted in your government google classroom and on our scholarship wall in the counseling office too! Remember local ones typically start to come out at the end of 1st semester beginning of 2nd semester

Listen for announcements and check your emails about upcoming college representatives in the counseling office during lunch

ATHLETES: register for the NCAA clearinghouse if you plan to participate in inter-collegiate sports
