13) GE Reagan Foundation Scholarship Program - \$40,000 – 20 Awards (Deadline: January 3, 2020)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

B) Demonstrate strong academic performance (minimum 3.0 grade point average/4.0 scale or equivalent).

8) SuperMoney's Financial Literacy Scholarship - \$2,500 - 1 Award (Deadline: December 31, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolled full-time in high school as a senior or be a part-time or full-time student in a college, graduate school, trade school, or coding bootcamp.
- B) Have an overall average GPA of at least 3.0.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CHRISTMAS HOLIDAYS

1) Edison Scholars Program - \$40,000 - 30 Awards (Deadline: December 16, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Must be a high school senior with at least a cumulative 3.0 GPA, plan to pursue studies in the STEM fields at a four-year accredited college or university and show financial need.

B) Eligible STEM majors include computer and information systems, engineering, engineering technology, management information systems, mathematics, natural resources and conservation and physical sciences.
